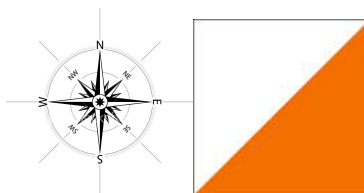

# 2012 Scout Orienteering Event

For the 14th year, the Badger Orienteering Club will hold its annual scout event. Form one or more teams from your troop and join the fun! (We recommend a maximum team size of 3-4 scouts, for the best experience.) **Girl and Boy Scouts** are encouraged to join the fun! For Boy Scouts, this is a great opportunity to fulfill part of the requirements toward the **Orienteering Merit Badge!!**

This is a "Score-O" event. Participants try to find as many of the control markers as they can within a 45-minute time limit. Participants can visit controls in any order, but must return to the finish within 45 minutes to avoid penalty points.

***IMPORTANT:*** Read, sign and return the Waiver form with registration. Each participating Troop will be responsible for its Scouts, including securing permission from parents for each Scout to participate. Scout leaders may sign the waiver as guardian for junior participants, with the understanding that the participant's parent or legal guardian has given their respective permission for the child to attend this event.

***WHAT TO BRING:*** Scouts should bring a compass if they have one, although the course can be navigated without one. Scouts should wear clothes suitable for walking and running outdoors. Running shoes or boots are OK. Long pants or jeans, and long-sleeved shirts are advised. Bring suitable outdoor gear for the weather conditions (jacket, poncho or rain suit, gloves, hat, etc.). Orienteering meets are held rain or shine!
